

Parish council Sandwich- Police Report Monday 24th November 2014.

103 calls were made to Kent Police between 1st November 14 – 23rd November 14 for Sandwich. No further nuisance motor bike calls received for A256/Monks Way.

Speed enforcement carried out on 24th October 14 in Ramsgate road late afternoon. Two vehicles were stopped and reported for excessive speed.

Elderly residents have been targeted by individuals selling cleaning products door to door on various occasions during the past month. Local officers have produced bespoke laminated cards with all the appropriate Kent Police phone numbers should they have any concerns with door sellers.

Crimes of note
