

# Sandwich: Kent Police update for May 2015

I am your neighbourhood PCSO for Sandwich Ward.

On Wednesday 13th May 2015 a day of action was executed in Sandwich, this involved PCSO's, Police Officers and Special Constables spending their shifts on high visibility patrol. During the Operation a quantity of alcohol was confiscated from a local male who was consuming it in public. Speed checks were carried out at various locations within the town as a result two Traffic Offences Reports were issued to vehicles in Sandown road. This was the first day of action in the Dover District with more being planned for the future.

Over the past month offenders have gained entry to a disused site and a number of tools were taken. A peddle cycle was stolen from outside the Coop Sandwich, which had been left insecure. Tools were also stolen from an insecure builders van parked in Laburnum Avenue. These investigations are on-going at this time.

## Local Officers Update

PCSO's Norton and Lee have been changing their shifts to enable them to be on patrol in Sandwich more often on Wednesday afternoons, as this time has been highlighted as having an increase in Anti-Social behaviour.

PCSO's Norton and Lee have also been stopping and speaking with schools children walking to and from school who are seen smoking or causing Anti-Social Behaviour. PCSO's have the power to search under 16's for tobacco products, and this power is regularly enforced.

Local officers have also been attending the Phoenix Centre Youth Club and engaging with the young persons visiting the centre.

Following reports of smells of cannabis from a block of flats in Jubilee road Sandwich local officers attended the address over a period of time. As result a resident has received a joint visit from Kent Police and the housing provider. The occupant has received a warning.

PCSO Norton has been patrolling on his Police cycle in the town, this form of patrolling is effective as the cycle can access areas car are unable to.
