(i) The Committee was asked to clarify whether the resolution of the Council made on 21st December 2015, minute point 21.12.15 (ii) (i), *That DDC be asked to contact the Land Registry so that the Register of Title may be amended as necessary to reflect the Town Council's ownership of properties* signified the Council's intention that all properties should be transferred to ownership of Sandwich Town Council, rather than Sandwich Toll Bridge Fund.
